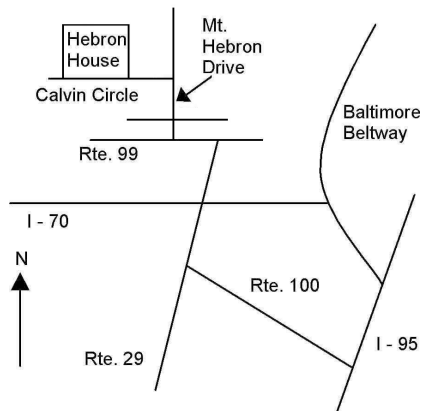


Directions

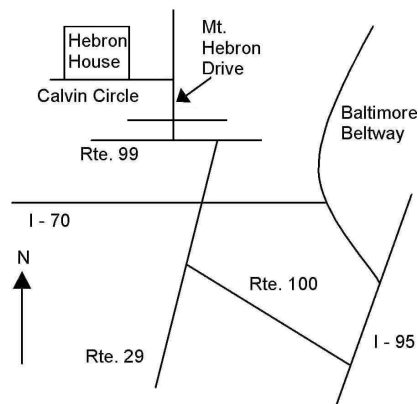
